# NGĀ TOI TŪHONO

A new and exciting kaupapa has been made available to us called Ngā Toi Tūhono - Whānau engagement through Māori Fine Arts. This opportunity was made possible by Te Runanga Nui o Te Aupōuri and Tautoru Ltd. It will be provided to our Year 5 - 11 students. The kaupapa encourages tauira to create toi māori and open career pathways. The course will be delivered across 4 wānanga over the next 2 terms. The first 2 wānanga will take place in Whangārei this term, and the remaining 2 wānanga will take place in term 4.

The first wānanga in Whangārei will take place in 2 weeks time from **Wednesday 10 - Friday 12 August** at Te Puna o Te Mātauranga. We are extremely fortunate to have this opportunity fully funded by the Ministry of Education. Detailed information is provided at the back of this pānui.

# BOARD OF TRUSTEES ELECTIONS NOMINATIONS

Our triennial Board of Trustees nominations are now **OPEN**. If you or someone you know is interested in becoming a Board of Trustee member, please complete the nomination form and return to the Returning Officer before nominations close next **Wednesday 3 August 2022** at **noon**. If you would like a nomination form printed, please collect one from our office. There's not much time left e te whānau so get those nominations in quick before closing.

### Nominating yourself or someone else

If you are on the voting roll and eligible to vote, you can nominate yourself. Please remember to sign both parts of the form. If you are nominating someone else, complete the nomination form and make sure it includes all the required contact details and signatures.

You can post, hand deliver or email your nomination form/s to the returning officer (see details below).

## Nominations close at noon on 3rd August 2022.

### **Candidate statement**

If you are a candidate, you are invited to submit an optional statement (up to 400 words) and photo. Make sure your statement is received by noon on 3rd August 2022 so that it can be sent to voters with the voting papers. The returning officer may remove or edit any part of the candidate's statement if it exceeds 400 words or is offensive or defamatory.

### **Electoral roll**

The electoral roll is held at the school office and can be viewed during normal school hours.

### Eligibility

Anyone can stand for election to the board, except for some exclusions. Please check information on who is not eligible. If you are not on the voting roll you must be nominated by a person who is.

### Voting and results

Electronic voting will be an option for this election. If there are more nominations than vacancies for parent representatives, a voting election will be held. Eligible voters will be issued voting papers and candidate statements, on or before **10th August 2022.** 

The poll closes at 4pm on 7th September 2022. The highest polling candidates will be elected to the board, and results will be notified to the school community and other affected parties.
